English

In English, this term, the children will be writing balanced arguments. These will have a real audience and be sent to the local M.P. They will also be writing spooky stories which are based on the book "Boo" by Kevin Crossley-Holland. This is all supplemented with reading, spelling and grammar to support their writing.

Maths

Maths, at St. Peter's, is taught using the White Rose Maths approach, which focuses on maths mastery—children are taught to fully grasp topics, not just scrape the surface, so by the time they move on to more advanced lessons they have a deep understanding of foundational concepts. Art and Design— Drawing

In this block, pupils will combine techniques learnt in previous lessons to create the illusion of depth and represent the translucent qualities of water.

Science

Children will learn about the circulatory system in humans. They will develop an understanding about blood and blood vessels, the functions of the heart and how to keep healthy
