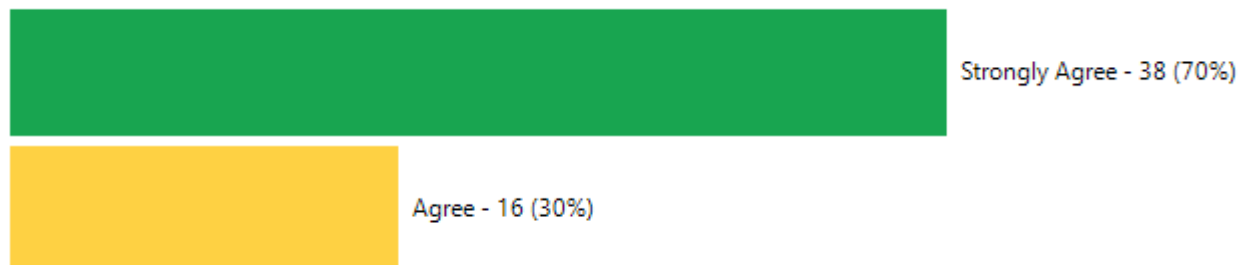

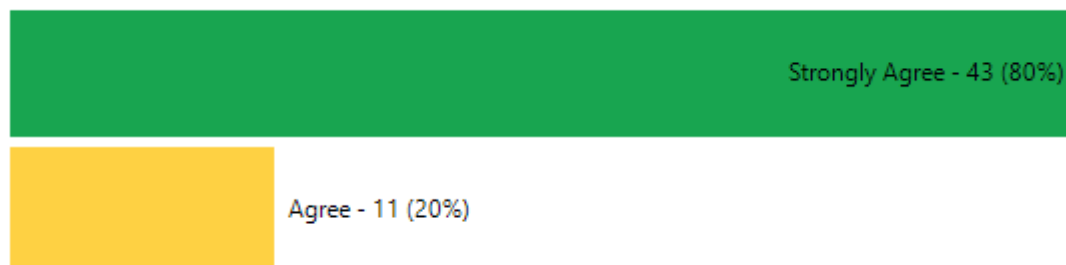

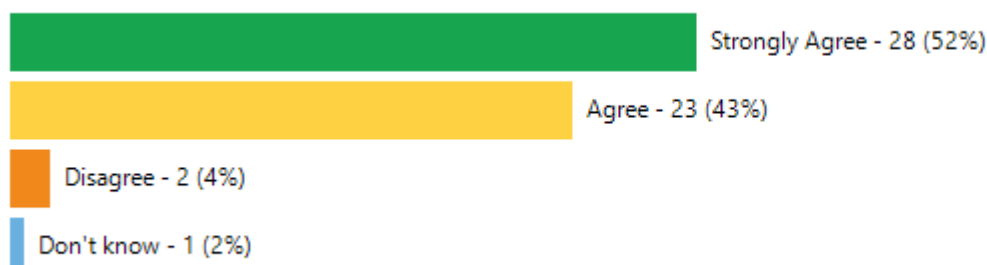
Q1. How much do you agree or disagree with the statement: "My child is happy at this school"

Q3. How much do you agree or disagree with the statement: "The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved"



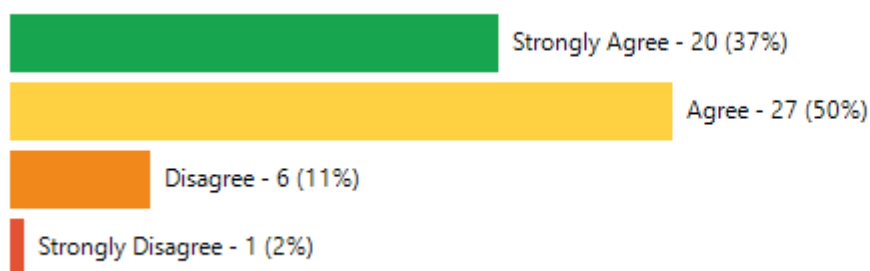

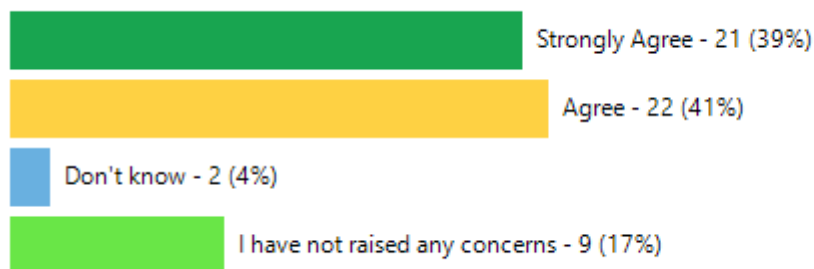
Q4. How much do you agree or disagree with the statement: "My child has been bullied and the school dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively"

Q6. How much do you agree or disagree with the statement: "When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly"



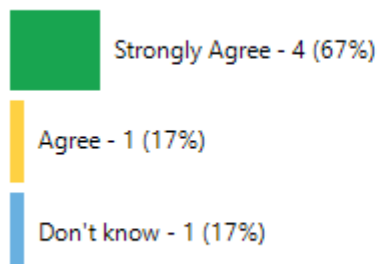
Q7. Does your child have special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND)?



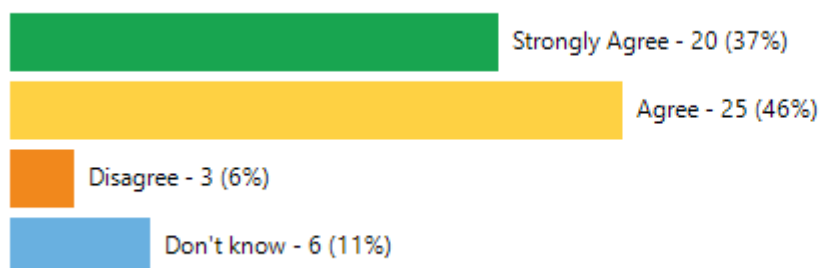

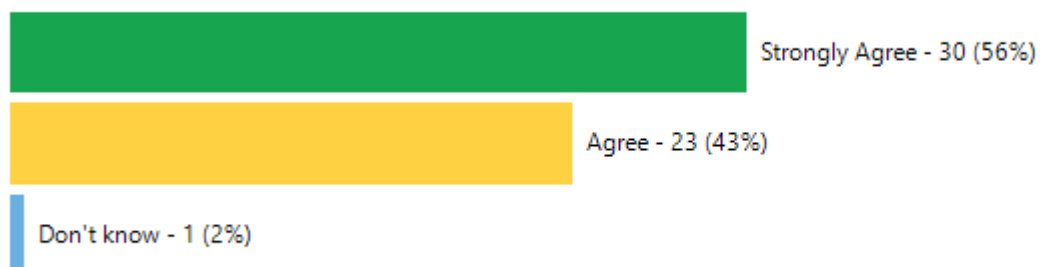
Q8. How much would you agree or disagree with this statement: "My child has SEND, and the school gives them the support they need to succeed"



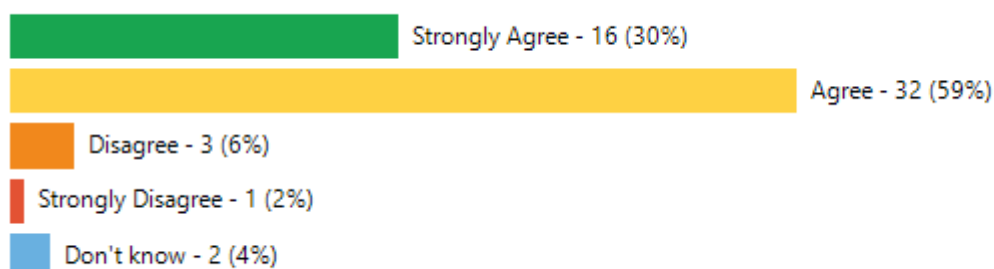
Q9. How much would you agree or disagree with the statement: "The school has high expectations for my child"

Q11. How much do you agree or disagree with the statement: "The school lets me know how my child is doing"



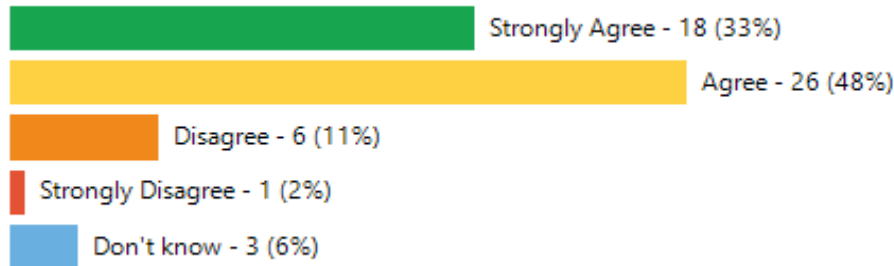

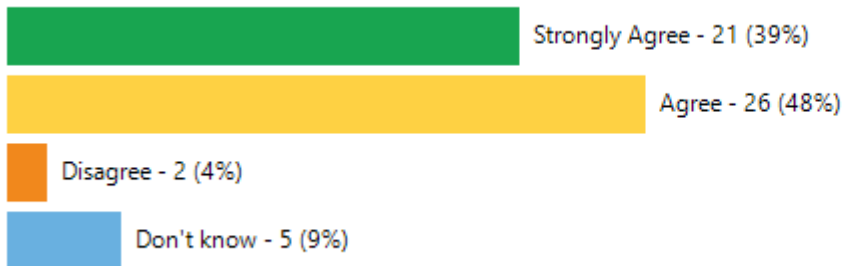
Q12. How much do you agree or disagree with the statement: "There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school"
